# Elementary/Secondary Teacher Education Scholarship



### Elementary/Secondary Teacher Education Scholarship

- Awarded to a high school senior or an undergraduate or post graduate student who is majoring in an Elementary or Secondary School Teacher Education Program.
- Applicant must provide a college transcript or letter of acceptance from the college or university stating the applicant has been accepted into the Teacher Education program.
- The minimum award is \$1500.

### Eligibility

- Applicants must be a U.S. citizen and a resident of the State of Colorado and attend an accredited college or university in the United States.
- Applicants do not need to be members of the DAR.
- Please do not submit a personal photograph as the scholarship is judged and awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin, or disability.
- All awards are judged based on academic excellence, commitment to field of study (as required), and financial need by a committee of judges outside the NSDAR.
- Upon receipt of proof of registration, the scholarship award will be paid directly to the recipient's college or university no later than June 30<sup>th</sup> and will be applied to the upcoming academic year.
- No person shall receive the same scholarship award more than once.
